Site Inductions & Signing-in

Site inductions are a crucial process for customer site access; their purpose is to provide essential information and familiarise workers with safety protocols, potential hazards, emergency procedures and site operational procedures.

You are also required to sign-in to site for various reasons such as security, access control and personal safety.

Depending on the site and their systems, these processes can vary however the bottom line is always the same -

no induction and no sign-in = NO SITE ACCESS

This is an essential compliance requirement and up to you to flag to your manager or to health & safety if you arrive to site unequipped with the above.


